Coffee table 1053 was designed by Josef Frank for Svenskt Tenn in 1940 and was relaunched in 2014 in connection with the exhibition "A tribute to the furniture designer Josef Frank".

Josef Frank often mixed different materials in his furniture, and in this coffee table, the tabletop in travertine meets a base in solid lacquered brass. The characteristic table legs can be found in several of Josef Frank's designs. The table has been depicted in photographs from different interiors, including Estrid Ericson's living room at Strandvägen 5 in front of a Liljevalchs sofa.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Svenskt Tenn's furniture is made from wood and then lacquered. The woodwork should be cleaned simply with a soft cloth dampened with mild dish detergent or soapy water. Make sure to dry it with a soft cloth.

Polish, oil or abrasive cleaners should never be used on the furniture. Never expose the furniture to prolonged humidity or direct heat. If an injury in the paint or wood occurs, you should immediately contact a furniture restorer. Often you can restore easier damage, but the damage is likely to worsen if not taken care of. Never move the furniture by dragging it across the floor.

The furniture lacquer can be damaged by direct heat and lengthy exposure to dampness.
