**THE ROUND DINING TABLE** in elmroot, walnut, mahogany and birch was designed by Josef Frank for Svenskt Tenn around 1940. He created both the column base and the chequered intarsia edging based on an English model. The mix of different types of wood is a typical feature of Josef Frank's classic design. The table is nowadays produced by the firm of master carpenters Eriksson och Söner outside Nyköping.

MATERIAL Elm root with inlays of walnut and birch. Legs in mahogany.

**CARE INSTRUCTIONS** Svenskt Tenn's furniture is made from wood and then lacquered. The woodwork should be cleaned simply with a soft cloth dampened with mild dish detergent or soapy water. Make sure to dry it with a soft cloth.

Polish, oil or abrasive cleaners should never be used on the furniture. Never expose the furniture to prolonged humidity or direct heat. If an injury in the paint or wood occurs, you should immediately contact a furniture restorer.
