



GLAS CABINET FÖNSTERGRÖNSKA

SEBASTIAN HEDENGRAHN designed the glass cabinet “Fönstergrönska” (Window Greenery) in conjunction with the 2014 exhibition “Ta om hand” (Take care of), which was a collaboration between Carl Malmsten Furniture Studies and Svenskt Tenn. After having manufactured Josef Frank furniture for many years, AH Eriksson & Sons Carpenters had an entire building full of left-over veneer sheets from various roots small offshoots. Nine students from the Furniture Design Programme at Carl Malmsten Furniture Studies were tasked with taking care of the left-over sheets.

MATERIAL Lacquered cherry wood with sides of glass and cabinet bottom of wavona root veneer. Sliding glass doors with brass knobs.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS Svenskt Tenn's furniture is made from wood and then lacquered. The woodwork should be cleaned simply with a soft cloth dampened with mild dish detergent or soapy water. Make sure to dry it with a soft cloth.

Polish, oil or abrasive cleaners should never be used on the furniture. Never expose the furniture to prolonged humidity or direct heat . If an injury in the paint or wood occurs, you should immediately contact a furniture restorer .

The furniture lacquer can be damaged by direct heat and lengthy exposure to dampness.

Avoid exposing your furniture to large changes in temperature and humidity, which can significantly affect natural movements of the wood.
