A large walnut and glass display cabinet designed by Josef Frank in 1957. This cabinet, with cabriole-style legs and so-called club feet, is a typical example of an English display cabinet – perfect for showing off beautiful and exciting objects in a home. Josef Frank believed that the display cabinet could be part of a modern interior and that the objects placed in the cabinet did not necessarily have to be of the same type. Instead, beautiful things should be mixed with useful ones, as is usually done in the rest of the home

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Svenskt Tenn's furniture is made from wood that is varnished or coated.

Clean with a soft cloth dampened with mild dish detergent or soapy water. Dry with a soft cloth. Wipe the glass with glass cleaner and a soft cloth. Do not expose the furniture to prolonged humidity or direct heat or use polish, oil or abrasive cleaners on the furniture.

Avoid placing vases, books, placemats and the like, on the cabinet top when the furniture is new, as colour variations can occur on the surface. Also avoid exposing the furniture to large changes in temperature and humidity.

Contact a furniture restorer if the coating or wood gets damaged, as it can get worse if not tended to.
