









## ARMCHAIR 789

**ARMCHAIR 789 IN MAHOGANY** was designed by Josef Frank for Svenskt Tenn in 1938. Its transparent back expresses Josef Frank's ideas of keeping the interior light and airy and free from restrictive obstacles and walls. The design is typical of the early Victorian period and in England is generally referred to as a Captain's chair. The chair is nowadays produced by Gemla, Sweden's oldest furniture factory.

MATERIAL Mahogany. Seat upholstered with horse hair

**CARE INSTRUCTIONS** Svenskt Tenn's furniture is made from wood that is varnished or coated. Clean with a soft cloth dampened with mild dish detergent or soapy water. Dry with a soft cloth. Do not expose the furniture to prolonged humidity or direct heat or use polish, oil or abrasive cleaners on the furniture.

Contact a furniture restorer if the coating or wood gets damaged, as it can get worse if not tended to.
